Trieste Airport-City center Trieste

The airport is connected by bus no. 51 which goes to the bus terminal in front of the bus and railway station in Trieste.

- the bus departs **every 30 minutes** on work days and every 1-2 hours on weekends
- the ride between the airport and the bus station lasts for about an hour
- the **last departure from the airport is at 23:30**
- tickets at the airport can be purchased at a ticket machine or the tourist office
- tickets for the ride to the airport can be purchased at bus stations
- the ticket costs around 4€.
